- **If you apply for the working student position:** You should pursue a degree in an accredited bachelor's or master's programme in/close to Stuttgart, e.g. Software Engineering, Computer Science, Human Computer Interaction, Media Informatics, Information Systems, or similar. You should be able to work 8-20 hours per week on site in our Stuttgart studio. During the semester break you can work up to 40 hours per week.
